5.4. 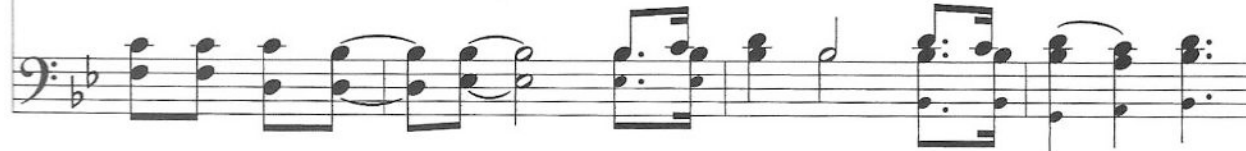
